

# CHOOSE E15

## What is E15?

E15 is a fuel that contains 15% ethanol and 85% gasoline. Most fuels (ie: unleaded octane rating 87 - 91) contain 10% ethanol.

E15 can be found at gas stations throughout Minnesota and is also branded as Unleaded Plus and Unleaded 88.



## Can You Use E15?

If you own a vehicle that's 2001 or newer, then yes! In 2011, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced that all light-duty vehicles made in 2001 or later can use E15.

Furthermore, you'll be pleased to know that the EPA tested E15 over 6.5 million miles before approving its use in light-duty vehicles 2001 and newer.

## What Are The Benefits of Using E15?

E15 is cheaper than regular unleaded octane 87 gasoline. Second, because ethanol has a high octane rating, E15 has an octane rating of 88, which is better for your vehicle.

Ethanol is also cleaner than gasoline so when you use E15, your vehicle emits fewer greenhouse gases. Moreover, ethanol is a homegrown fuel so when you use E15, you are boosting Minnesota's economy and reducing our dependence on foreign oil.
